Grand Union Covid-19 Guidelines

Grand Union is keen to restart workshops and masterclasses in a safe environment. Before returning to regular sessions we will:

*confirm with the venue that health and safety compliance checks are in place, and carry out a revised Risk Assessment in line with latest guidance, identifying protective measures to minimise risks of Covid-19 transmission. *remind participants that masks/face coverings should be worn on public transport.

*consider the issues surrounding students who may be in vulnerable groups.

Social Distancing

We will aim for a 2 metre distancing at all times, including a clearly signed route into the space. If social distancing is not possible, masks can be worn where appropriate.

We aim to keep the group a smaller size to take into account the space available - 15 participants to start with. This will allow for adequate ventilation and space for participants to be positioned side by side.

Instruments and Equipment

Grand Union instruments will be cleaned before and after sessions. This website has links on cleaning specific instruments <https://www.candomusic.org>. Sanitisers and wipes, and handwashing facilities will be available. Usually participants will only use one instrument and handling of music, stands etc will be minimised. Participants will be asked to bring:

own instrument water and lunch/snack
mask and hand sanitiser Pencil and notebook

Registration

Grand Union keeps a register of participants with contact details. If a tutor or participant has any Covid-19 symptoms or has come into contact with the confirmed case, they must inform the Music Leader. There will be no further sessions for 14 days if this occurs.
